WHAT IS A NON-TRADITIONAL RESEARCH SITE?

Recruitment Partner's non-traditional research sites include nursing homes, assisted living facilities and adult day centers. Traditional clinical trial sites, such as doctor's offices, academic research institutes or clinical research practices, have many barriers to participation, especially for persons with Alzheimer's and their caregiver. By developing these communities as the clinical trial site, many of these challenges are resolved and eligible patients can participate in cutting-edge research in environments and with providers with which they are familiar.

The principal investigator, rater and study coordinator comprise the **STUDY TEAM**. Recruitment Partners will help the care community look internally to fill these roles or find qualified individuals to pair with the community as RP Independent Contractors.

THE PROCESS

On-Site Visit

Recruitment Partners will visit the care community. This visit helps us to learn more about the community and review its current capacity to deliver a clinical trial and estimate the number of residents that qualify for the trial.

Capacity Building

Through hands-on preparation and coaching, Recruitment Partners works with these communities to equip them to meet the requirements of a specific protocol. This may include identifying study staff, equipment, certifications, and training.

Workshop & Trainings

Recruitment Partners will hold a half-day workshop with the study team. We will review Good Clinical Practice, develop processes for carrying out the trial, and prepare the community and study team for a Site Qualification Visit by the study sponsor.



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
